About MedHub

MedHub provides users with control and consistency across the enterprise while delivering a flexible solution that meets individual program needs. MedHub offers both Graduate Medical Education (GME) & Undergraduate Medical Education (UME) management in one system.

The MedHub enterprise system is funded by the Division of Medical Education, UC San Diego School of Medicine. Current UC San Diego Health Sciences faculty, staff, and students can access to this powerful tool free of charge, provided an account was established in MedHub. MedHub Features

- Personnel Management
 - Capture, store and manage your trainee and faculty demographics data in a centralized database.
- Program Administration
 - Track trainee activities and drive compliance with flexible tools built for disparate user groups.
- Performance Assessment
 - Design and distribute tools to evaluate the performance of all personnel across the institution.
- Schedule Management
 - Build and manage rotation schedules, call schedules and clinics to inform financial reporting.
- Institutional Oversight
 - Oversee projects across the entire enterprise with centralized compliance tracking and reporting.
- MedHub Mobile
 - Offline mode allows users to complete tasks from anywhere at any time and then upload to system when reconnected.
 - Tasks that can be performed include: View performance summaries; Initiate evaluations; Submit work hours; Log procedures; and Manage calendar.

Getting Started

MedHub is accessible by UC San Diego Health Sciences faculty, staff and students with an active account in the system. Access requires an account on the UCSD Active Directory (AD) system coupled with UCSD Duo two-step authentication registered and activated.
